## A Message From Our Cantor

### “A Time to Uproot and to Pull Down and a Time to Build and to Plant”

If you have recently walked into the 21<sup>st</sup> Street entrance of Temple Beth-El, you will have seen that TBE recently entered into what the prophet Jeremiah called a time “to uproot and to pull down” and a time “to build and to plant.”

As you may know, some months ago the main floor library, office and hallway areas sustained substantial water damage. In response to the flooding and damage, the Board of Directors, along with the able direction of a renovations committee headed by architect/TBE member Danielle Weintraub, has begun a renovations project for this area. The entrance, library, offices and hallway area will be renovated, according to beautifully rendered architectural plans, thus providing an aesthetically beautiful (and more security conscious) entrance to our synagogue.

In Hebrew, the expression “*hiddur mitzvah*” refers to the principle of enhancing a mitzvah through aesthetics -- or “beautifying a mitzvah.” One has only to raise the beautifully engraved family Kiddush cup on Friday evening, or to glimpse the sunlight refracted through the magnificent stained glass windows in our sanctuary to appreciate the spiritual lift that *hiddur mitzvah* can offer our religious observances.

In the spirit of *hiddur mitzvah*, Temple Beth-El, with the assistance of Temple Beth-El’s Foundation, has begun a capital campaign to secure funding for this much needed project. As a member of Temple Beth-El, you may have recently been asked, or will soon be asked to contribute to the process of updating and beautifying Temple Beth-El.

If you have any questions about the renovations or the funding drive, you may contact Dr. Jimmy Krell, who is heading up the capital campaign for the synagogue.

Rabbi Goldsmith and I join in asking that you consider giving within your means to this worthy project of “*hiddur mitzvah*.” At Temple Beth-El, we are truly blessed with the privilege of studying and praying in a beautiful synagogue, one which our forebears lovingly invested not only their financial resources, but also their vision for a future of Conservative Jewish life in Birmingham.

There are times within the life of a community when we are asked to re-commit to that vision, in order to vouchsafe the future of our community. Today is such a time “to build and to plant,” as we prepare to re-commit to the vision of those who preceded us at Temple Beth-El.

## A Message From Our Education Department

### Working In Unison For TBE's Youth

In the Babylonian Talmud (Shavuot 39a) we find the phrase; "kol yisrael arevim zeh bazeh," commonly rendered in English as; "all of Israel is responsible for one another." That translation, however, does not convey the depth of this concept. To be responsible for someone, in a manner of speaking, alleviates the mutual obligation that the phrase evokes in the Hebrew. Helping a person in a time of need does not free that person from helping him/herself, or from providing for others when the opportunity presents itself. Similarly, seeking the help of the same small circle of individuals because they have shown themselves to be "community minded" is also an unfair expectation, according to our tradition.



The Temple Beth-El family is just that, a family. There are elders and children, volunteers and participants, leaders and followers, those who give and those who receive. That is the nature of most families and of most organizations; the healthy ones anyway. It is that very balance between the various parties that creates the positive energy necessary to grow. For the youth and education programs to succeed, the various arms of the Temple must work in concert with each other, pushing and pulling those who believe they have no share in this endeavor.

We are blessed with a Sisterhood that provides funds for our school and youth; and Men's Club that provides tefilin for the world wide wrap, but that is not enough. We need teachers who are passionate and prepared, students who appreciate those efforts, and parents who support the program. That mutual obligation will go a long way in making our Hebrew School, youth groups and Jr. Congregation a source of pride for our community.

This year, the first day of Hebrew School will begin on Sunday the 28<sup>th</sup> of August at 9:00 am. The first day of afternoon classes will begin Wednesday the 31<sup>st</sup> of August at 3:30pm, and Hebrew High will begin at 6:00pm. Mahzor Lev Shalem, edited by Ed Feld, was published last summer. It has already sold over 120,000 copies. At the time of its release, the mahzor received accolades in the Jewish and non-Jewish press.

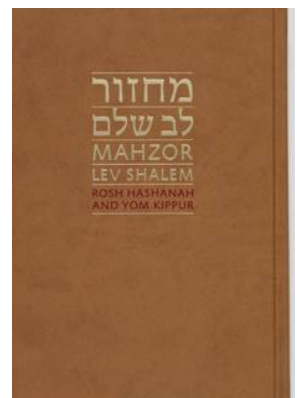
According to its description by the publishers,

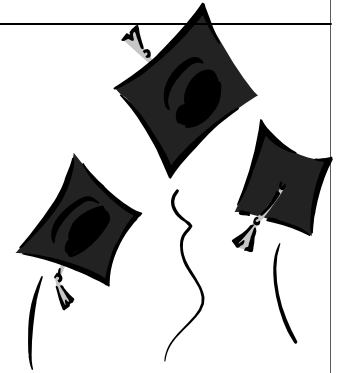

May this year of Torah Fund activities and events be a blessing to one and all.

In the campaign just completed, nearly 100 women participated; we hope we will have your support again. We have set an ambitious goal, but one that we think can and will be achieved because you recognize the need to support The Jewish Theological Seminary. The monies that we raise go towards scholarships which provide much needed education funds for our future rabbis, cantors, educational directors, etc.
