Plans are being finalized now to complete the repairs to our building resulting from the water leak earlier this year. Asbestos had to be removed before we could "put our house back in order." Rabbi Goldsmith's Excellent Adventure

I recently lead 11 confirmation students on a trip to New York. Along with fellow chaperone and congregant Scott Bloomston, we visited the Jewish Museum and the Eldridge Street Synagogue and Museum. We took the ferry to Ellis Island and the Statue of Liberty. We also saw a great Broadway Show and went to the 86th floor of the Empire State Building. Throughout the trip, the students and I were reminded of the many trials and tribulations that our ancestors endured, fleeing from persecution and hatred in the Old World, to come to a new world, with new opportunities in the United States. By the time we left, we each felt blessed more than ever to be part of this great country.

72 hours after returning from New York, I had the opportunity to participate in two events that made me realize how far Jews have come since our relatives landed at Ellis Island. Both events were held at the White House on May 17, 2011 as part of Jewish American Heritage Month. Just writing those words fills me with amazement. What would my great-grandmother have thought if someone suggested to her that someday the President of the United States would invite her great-grandaughter to celebrate our Jewish heritage at the White House?

No doubt she would have told them they were crazy, but she would have been wrong. My husband Jeff and I attended two such events. The first was a briefing for 80 Jewish community leaders from around the country. We heard from Dan Shapiro, Senior Director, Middle East & North Africa, National Security Council as he spoke about President Obama's commitment to "Strengthening the U.S. – Israel Relationship." He explained the many ways in which the two governments cooperate on defense, told us that when Prime Minister Netanyahu meets with President Obama later this week it will mark his seventh meeting at the White House (more than any other leader of a foreign country), and that President Obama is committed to promoting peace, but not at Israel's expense. Following Director Shapiro's speech we heard from representatives of the Office of



Public Engagement and the Office of Communications. We also heard from Brian Deese, the Special Assistant to the President & Deputy Director, National Economic Council, who explained President Obama's economic vision for our country.

After lunch, we attended a special reception for 250 invited guests at the White House. The attendees were a mix of rabbis from various denominations (I was one of only a handful of Conservative rabbis), major Jewish supporters of President Obama, and leaders of Jewish organizations and institutions.

It is hard to describe the overwhelming feeling of being at the White House for such an event. The military band played a mixture of classical music, melodies from Jewish liturgy, and Israeli folk songs. Jewish communal greats such as Elie Weisel, Supreme Court Justice Ruth Bader-Ginsburg, and Supreme Court Justice Stephen Breyer were in attendance. The Maccabeats also performed. Tears glistened in my eyes as I watched and listened to a group of Yeshivah University students sing *Al-Hanisim, L'chah Dodi* (to the melody of "Hallelujah") and "I throw my latkes in the air sometimes" in the East Room of the White House. They noted it was the greatest day of their lives, performing on the same stage where the President of the United States was going to speak momentarily. And I actually felt choked up, almost forgetting to breathe, as President Obama praised all of US for coming to celebrate with HIM the contributions the Jewish American community has made to this great country.

This was only the second annual reception in honor of Jewish American Heritage month and it was an honor and a blessing to attend.

For years I have followed my nightly recitation of the *Shema al ha-mitah* – the Shema before bedtime - with a personal prayer thanks to God for granting me the gift of being born in this great country. Those words of gratitude were even more heart-felt upon my return from the White House and this special experience. Each Shabbat at synagogue we pray that God guides the leaders of our government and their advisors. As we reach a crossroads in the Middle East and trouble brews all around our beloved Israel, I pray that indeed God truly guides President Obama to be wise, just, and compassionate in all that he does on behalf of the Jewish people.

New Mahzor for Rosh Hashanah & Yom Kippur

This year during the High Holidays, Temple Beth-El will introduce a new Mahzor to the congregation.

Mahzor Lev Shalem, edited by Ed Feld, was published last summer. It has already sold over 120,000 copies. At the time of its release, the mahzor received accolades in the Jewish and non-Jewish press.

According to its description by the publishers,

“Lev Shalem seeks to embrace the diverse backgrounds and expectations in each of our communities and open doors for every congregant. For the congregant who is familiar with the t’fillah, the mahzor’s running commentary presents both a historical overview and insight into the meaning of prayers. For the congregant who doesn’t know Hebrew, the English translations are close to the meaning of the original and the transliterations are

plentiful.

For the seeker who comes to services looking for meaning and direction, the mahzor’s rich -assortment of readings includes classic piyyutim that appear in Conservative publications for the first time; Hasidic stories and reflections; and quotes from Abraham Joshua Heschel, Martin Buber, contemporary Israeli and American poets, and leading rabbis in the Conservative movement and beyond. And with abundant readings that focus on spiritual issues and tikkun olam, Mahzor Lev Shalem speaks to the contemporary concerns of our congregants. The book represents the best of the Conservative movement—the classical and the contemporary, the historical and the spiritual; it promises to be inspiring and relevant for years to come.”

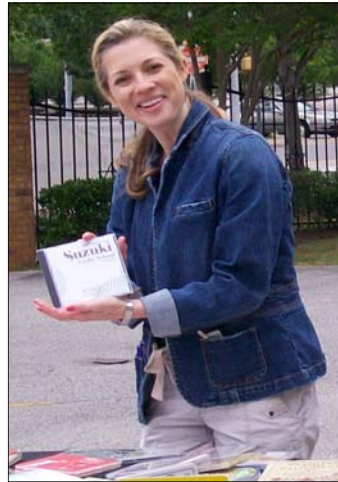

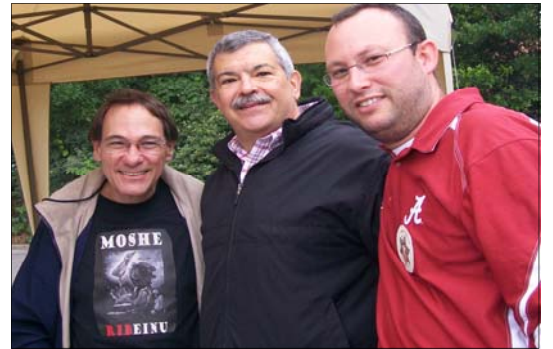

New Torah Fund Campaign Begins July 1st



Hiddur Mitzvah - הידור מצוה

The concept of Hiddur Mitzvah—embellishing a mitzvah through aesthetics (for example, making an exceptional Shabbat meal using your best china or building a beautiful sukkah beyond minimum religious standards or having the love and willingness to give just a little bit more than you had planned)—is attributed to a midrash (Mekhilta de Rabbi Ishmael) on a verse in the Song of the Sea: “This is my God and I will glorify Him” (Exodus 15:2). With enhancement and adornment, the mitzvot appeal to the senses and the heart, and sacred objects and activities become even more precious.

Hiddur Mitzvah, this year’s Torah Fund theme, resonates with many Jewish women, particularly those who have been involved in artistic activities. Whether they used their embroidery skills to decorate the woven curtains for the Ark or Torah mantles in 17th-century Italy and Prague or were crafters in 20th-century women’s groups, women continue to be committed to this most ancient of Jewish values.

The pomegranate imagery of this year’s Torah Fund Pin has multilayered meaning. In addition to being beautiful, pomegranates (*rimmonim*) are one of the bountiful fruits of the Land of Israel. *Rimmonim* is also the term used for the silver adornments (finials) on the *atzei chaim* (Torah rollers) of the Sefer Torah (Torah scroll); just a little something extra that has adorned our Land, our Torah, our rituals, and mitzvot for centuries, and added meaning to our daily lives. May this year of Torah Fund activities and events be a blessing to one and all.
