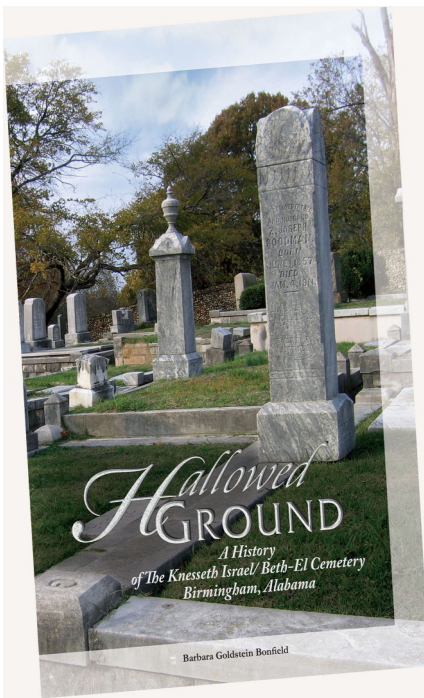


# Hallowed Ground Available for Purchase
